THE SHORT ANSWER IS: NO!

THE LONG ANSWER IS...

CLASSROOM HEADPHONES ARE PROVIDED FOR YOU TO LISTEN TO AND CREATE AUDIO FOR YOUR CLASSROOM ASSIGNMENTS. YOU MAY LISTEN TO MUSIC IF YOU FOLLOW THESE EXPECTATIONS:

- 1. YOU MAY LISTEN TO MUSIC ON PANDORA OR OTHER
  MUSIC ONLY WEBSITES. YOUTUBE AND OTHER VIDEO WEBSITES
  ARE NOT PERMITTED UNLESS OTHERWISE INSTRUCTED BY THE TEACHER.
- 2. YOUR MUSIC MUST BE SCHOOL APPROPRIATE. DO NOT CHOOSE SONGS, ARTISTS, OR CHANNELS THAT WILL CAUSE MUSIC WITH EXPLICIT LYRICS TO PLAY.
- 3. YOUR MUSIC SHOULD BE KEPT AT A VOLUME THAT ONLY YOU CAN HEAR.
- 4. WHEN THE TEACHER IS TALKING OR ASKING FOR YOUR ATTENTION, YOU MUST TURN OFF YOUR MUSIC IMMEDIATELY <u>AND</u> REMOVE THE HEADPHONES FROM YOUR EARS.
- 5. WHILE YOU ARE LISTENING TO CLASSROOM INSTRUCTION ON AUDIO OR VIDEO, YOU MAY NOT HAVE YOUR OWN MUSIC PLAYING IN THE BACKGROUND.
- 6. IF YOU BRING YOUR OWN HEADPHONES, YOU MAY USE THEM BY PLUGGING THEM INTO THE EMPTY SPOT IN THE HEADPHONE SPLITTER.
- 7. YOU MAY LISTEN TO MUSIC ON YOUR IPAD, INCLUDING YOUR OWN PURCHASED MUSIC, PROVIDED YOU MEET ALL OF THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS.
- 8. YOUR AUDIO PRIVILEGES MAY BE SUSPENDED AT ANY TIME IF YOU ARE NOT FOLLOWING THE RULES.
